

Ride the Wellington Cable Car / From Lambton Quay to the lookout at Kelburn, the historic Cable Car takes you to views across the city and harbour.

Visit Zealandia Eco-Sanctuary / A world-first conservation attraction just 10 minutes' drive from the city centre.

Explore our Universe / Maori mythology meets Big Bang science at Carter Observatory.

Take a Tour / Food, film-making or wildlife, let a passionate local show you their Wellington. Book at the i-SITE Visitor Centre.

Dining

Café culture / Find out why Wellington is world-famous for coffee at dozens of city cafes.

The Craft of Beer-making / Ask for a local brew at one of our bars and discover why Wellington is the craft beer capital.

Meals with a View / The waterfront is the perfect place for an evening meal and a relaxing stroll.

Taste of the Region / Sample local produce at Harbourside Market and artisan foods at City Market, on the waterfront near Te Papa every Sunday morning.

Cuba Street / Filled with trendy local fashion and high quality vintage stores.

Lambton Quay / Great high street and department store shopping.

Local Designs / Check out Willis Street, Featherston Street, Victoria Street, Wakefield Street, College Street and Cuba Street.

Souvenirs & Gifts / Te Papa museum and Allen Street have fantastic homeware and NZ souvenirs.

Markets Galore / Left Bank Night Market – Wed & Fri 5pm-11pm off Cuba Street. Frank Kitts Underground Market – Sat 10am-4pm. Capital Market – Tue to Sat from 10.30am. See the dining section for more markets.

Accessible City

Wellington has a compact, reasonably flat city centre and a city council committed to providing services and facilities that are accessible to everyone. Most attractions and public buildings can be easily accessed. Routes marked on this map show streets that have accessible ATMs and plenty of seating.

Mobility scooters are available from various city locations. They can be booked by people aged 18+ for up to four hours free of charge. Pick up a brochure or phone Wellington City Council on +64 4 499 4444 for more information.

Mobility parking permits are issued by CCS Disability Action to people who use a wheelchair or mobility device and/or are unable to walk 200 metres unaided. Permit holders are allowed to park in designated mobility parking spaces for the time indicated on the parking meter. For more information, contact CCS Disability Action on +64 4 568 9000.
